



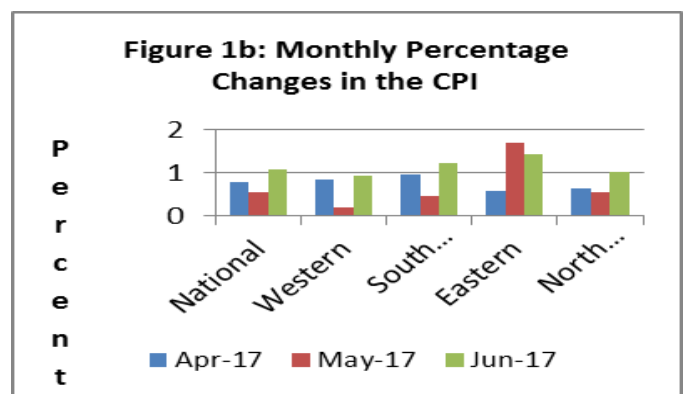
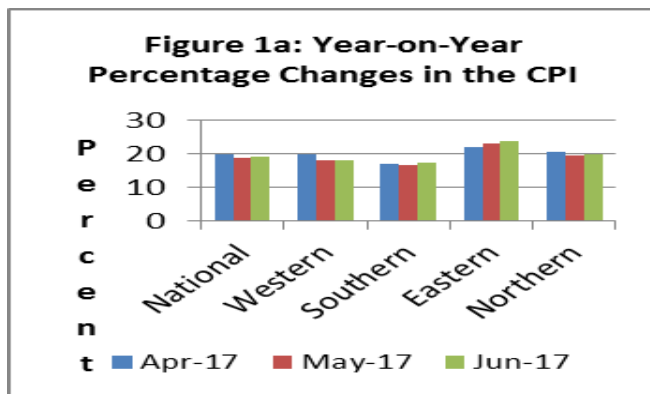
CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI) June, 2017: PRESS RELEASE

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JUNE 2017 MONTHLY INFLATION RATE INCREASES SIGNIFICANTLY

The national monthly CPI (2008=100) increased from 198.72 per cent in May, 2017 to 200.85 per cent in June, 2017 resulting in a 1.07 per cent increase in inflation rate this month. Similarly, the monthly rates of inflation increased in all the regions. Western Area (0.93 per cent), Northern Region (1.01 per cent), Southern region (1.21 per cent) and the Eastern Region (1.44 per cent) comprising two centers, Kenema (1.07 per cent) and Kono (1.84 per cent) during the same period.

Also, the national annual inflation rate for June, 2017 increased slightly from 18.91 per cent in May, 2017 to 19.14 per cent in June, 2017. Considering the regions, the year-on-year rates of inflation increased in the Eastern region from 23.15 per cent in May, 2017 to 23.73 per cent in June, 2017, in Northern region from 19.71 per cent to 19.76 per cent and in Southern region from 16.58 per cent to 17.43 per cent while the year-on-year rate of inflation decreased in the Western region from 18.09 per cent in May, 2017 to 18.07 per cent in June, 2017. Figures 1a & 1b below illustrate the movement in the year-on-year rates of inflation and monthly rates of inflation respectively for the National CPI and other CPI centers while table 1 below shows the National CPI from the months of June, 2016 to June, 2017 and the 12 month change in the CPI for the main index groups.



FACTORS INFLUENCING CHANGES IN THE MONTHLY RATE OF INFLATION

The national monthly CPI (2008=100) increased from 198.72 per cent in May, 2017 to 200.85 per cent in June, 2017 resulting in a 1.07 per cent increase in inflation rate this month. This reflects a monthly increase that is greater than the previous month, meaning that prices are increasing slightly at a higher rate. The increase in the price level for June 2017 was as a result of the increase in the demand for food items in the CPI basket due to the month of RAMADAN or Eid Mubarak and reinforced by the depreciation of the leone as against the foreign currencies especially the US dollar. The increase in the price level for June, 2017 was as a result of non-improvement in the exchange rate of the leone as against the forex especially the US dollar and reinforced by a decrease in the supply of most domestically produced food products especially the rice, palm oil, meat and fish reinforced. There was a general increase in the price level in all the four regions which affected most of the components in the CPI basket. At the national level, there were increases in the indices for the following groups; food and non-alcoholic beverages (1.05 per cent), housing, water, electricity, gas & other fuels (0.3 per cent), clothing and footwear (2.53 per cent), furnishing, household equipment and household maintenance (1.55 per cent), health (1.05 per cent), restaurant and hotels (0.62 per cent), transport (0.2 per cent), education (0.21 per cent) and communication (1.26 per cent).

The National CPI measures the change in prices, on average, from month to month, of the goods and services bought by most households, in Freetown, Bo, Kenema and Makeni including all expenditure groups and both families and single persons. Prices are collected for 400 items. All prices collected are the prevailing retail market prices from six (6) markets in the Greater Freetown area, three (3) Markets in Bo Town, three (3) markets in Kenema Town and two (2) markets in Makeni Town for weekly prices and other outlets for monthly items whose prices are less likely to fluctuate rapidly. The National Index was computed by aggregating the CPI for the four index towns previously published separately with different base periods. The old CPI series for Bo, Kenema, Makeni and Freetown were rebased to base year 2003, Computation methodology changed from the Modified to the Traditional Laspeyres, and transformed into the Classification of Individual Consumption by Purpose (COICOP) with 12 functions. The separate center CPIs were aggregated at the sub-class level at which level new weights were also introduced to obtain the Interim National Index.
